LHS SOFTBALL COACH NAMED IHSAA COACH OF THE YEAR

LEBANON, IN – Lebanon High School softball coach Shane Britt was recently named the State of Indiana Softball Coach of the Year by the Indiana High School Athletic Association. Coach Britt is in his second year as head coach of the Lebanon Tigers softball team. During his two years as head coach, he has compiled a Sagamore Conference Record of 28-0 and an overall record of 48-5.

Lebanon Athletic Director Phil Levine says, “Coach Britt has worked extremely hard to get our girls to play and reach their full potential. He is extremely dedicated, committed, and invested, not only in our softball program, but all Lebanon sports programs and the entire Lebanon community. Prior to being named head coach, Coach Britt was the assistant coach for the softball team for eight years, and has also coached with the LHS football and girls’ basketball programs.
